Galerie Ashiya Schule is pleased to present the 2<sup>nd</sup> solo exhibition of Kouseki Ono, titled *Inducer* from December 10, 2017 to January 27, 2018.

The works of Kouseki Ono include "shadows" in the plane print works and three-dimensional shapes in which "colour pillars" are attached to animal bones by the techniques of printing. In this exhibition we present the original print works, and three-dimensional works named *Inducer*, and a new experimental work combining cobwebs and screen prints.

Kouseki ONO won the grand prize of VOCA(Vision of Contemporary Art)in 2015, for his revolutionary print works. After that, he won the grand prize of 16<sup>th</sup> Okayama Arts and Culture Award in 2015, the grand prize of 2<sup>nd</sup> PAT (Print Art Triennale) in Kyoto in 2016.

Kouseki ONO has broadened the scope of his activities in recent years and is receiving greater recognition than ever before.
